## **WORKFORCE INVESTMENT NOTICE: 12-11**

**TO:** WORKFORCE INVESTMENT AREAS

**SUBJECT:** Dislocated Worker Allocations for PY 2013

**DATE:** June 28, 2013

Section **133(b)(2)(B)** of the WIA requires the Governor to prescribe the formula to be used in issuing allocations to the substate grantees. In prescribing the formula, the Governor, utilizing the most appropriate information available, shall assign weights to a set of five formula factors. The weights the Governor has assigned to the formula factors for the PY-2013 Dislocated Worker allocations are as follows:

<b><u>FORMULA FACTOR</u></b>	<b><u>WEIGHT</u></b>
Insured Unemployment Data	20%
Unemployment Averages	23%
Plant Closings & Mass Layoff Data	13%
Declining Industries Data – Net	15%
Long-term Unemployment Data	29%

**REFERENCES.** Reference is made to WIN 12-09 that transmitted to you the WIA percentage allocations for the Dislocated Worker program. Additional reference is made to TEGl 25-12.

The Dislocated Worker allocation for PY 2013 for the State of Rhode is **\$5,071,296**. The State Set-Aside for DW is 5%, which equals **\$253,565**. In addition, 25% of the DW allocation is reserved for Rapid Response which equals **\$1,267,824**. Seventy percent or **\$3,549,907** is to be distributed to the Local Areas according to the following percentages.

<b>WPGRI</b>	<b>68.93%</b>	<b>\$2,446,951</b>
<b>WSPC</b>	<b>31.07%</b>	<b>\$1,102,956</b>

Allotments are once again taken from two Federal budgets. The DW allocations are for the program period July 1, 2013, through June 30, 2014. Funds for Dislocated Worker programs will be split into PY13/FY14. I will provide you with those amounts via a separate WIN.
