**Course Outline/Topics to be Covered**

The Cardio-Phlebotomy Technician/Patient Care Technician program consists of three courses. Introduction to Health Care, Phlebotomy Techniques and EKG Techniques. Introduction to Health Care introduces students to the health care profession. It provides students with the fundamentals they need to develop their personal and professional skills, understanding their chosen profession in health care. General topics include today's health care system, medical law, understanding their chosen profession in health care. This course includes medical terminology for healthcare student to acquire a working knowledge of medical vocabulary and will teach how to understand surgical procedures, medical specialties and diagnostic procedures. Medical abbreviations and their uses in interpretation of medical orders and records are covered. The EKG Techniques course trains students to work in hospitals, clinics, emergency and trauma centers, private physicians' offices, outpatient centers and extended nursing care facilities.

The EKG Technician will be trained to operate and adjust EKG heart monitors and understand the results of the EKG. Topics include: Anatomy and Physiology of the heart, Holter Monitors, Interpreting and reading EKG recordings, Disease of the Heart, Introduction of EKG Monitors, and Communicating with Physicians. In addition, a 4 hour CPR component is included which covers adult, child and Infant and A.E.D.
