FOR A POLICE OFFICER RECRUITMENT

Candidates who wish to be considered for employment must be at least 21 years of age, a citizen of the United States and possess a valid driver's license. They must also have earned at least 60 credits, or an Associates Degree, in any course of study from an accredited college/university BEFORE THE APPLICATION DEADLINE. In lieu of college credits, candidates may substitute a combination of a high school diploma or GED certification AND two years, CONTINUOUS, ACTIVE-DUTY military service with honorable discharge OR have 5 years of current experience as a police officer. Applicants must be able to pass a physical agility test based on RIMPA standards and demonstrate an ability to swim. Starting salary is \$44,651 with step increases for patrol officers up to \$62,474 and includes a full range of benefits and educational reimbursement (conditions apply).
