	Duties will involve quantitative and qualitative chemical analysis of pollutants in air; maintenance of monitoring and analytical instruments in the field including air sampler setup, and filter analysis; QA/QC documentation, data handling and review. Field work requires climbing ladders, carrying equipment and driving to field testing sites in the state. To related work as required.
