











Percentage of Manufacturing Workforce Working in Durable Goods

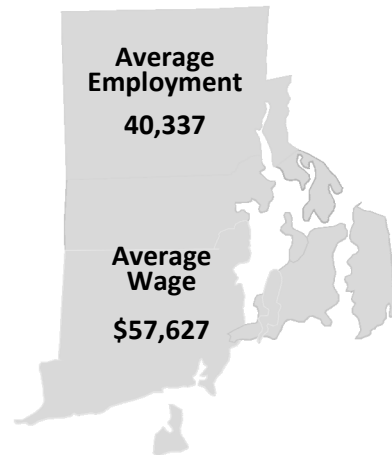

Durable Goods Manufacturing

Hard goods or goods that don't wear out quickly and last for a long period.

- Represented **62.2** percent or **25,103** of the total manufacturing workforce
- Average wage: \$59,602
- Transportation Equipment manufacturing represented 19.1 percent or 4,805 of the durable goods workforce.



Nondurable Goods Manufacturing

Soft goods or goods that have a short life cycle.

- Represented **37.8** percent or **15,234** of the total manufacturing workforce
- Average wage: \$54,372
- Chemical manufacturing represented 20.4 percent or 3,112 of the nondurable goods workforce.
