



2018 - 2020 Short Term Projections

RI Department of Labor and Training Labor Market Information

The occupational and industry projections for Rhode Island are based on national models developed by the Bureau of Labor Statistics which incorporate state specific data – industry employment series, staffing patterns, manufacturing hours, housing starts, and unemployment rates. Projected annual openings include openings due to exits (workers leaving an occupation) and openings due to transfers (workers transferring into an occupation). Statewide short-term projections are revised annually and are currently available for the 2018-2020 estimation period.
