**Weekly Update of Claims Activity**

**Week Ending: April 2, 2016**

***Unemployment Insurance***

**Initial Claims** – 818 initial claims were processed during the week ending 4/2/16, a decrease of 85 from the previous week, and an increase of 137 from a year ago. The number of initial claims filed to date is down 6.8 percent from last year and down 18.5 percent from two years ago.

**Continued Claims** – 11,124 continued claims were processed during the week of 4/2/16, a decrease of 524 from the previous week and a decrease of 1,821 from a year ago. The number of continued claims filed to date is down 13.4 percent from last year and down 24.6 percent from two years ago.

**Workshare** – gives employers an alternative to layoffs by allowing employees to work reduced hours and collect a percentage of regular UI benefits to compensate for lost pay. This week, 24 initial claims and 274 continued claims were processed. An estimated 6 layoffs were prevented this week, as a result of Workshare.

**Exhaustions** – 169 individuals exhausted their regular payments this week, a decrease of 20 from the previous week and a decrease of 59 from a year ago.

***Temporary Disability Insurance***

**Temporary Disability Insurance** – 876 initial claims and 8,138 continued claims were processed for Temporary Disability Insurance. The average weekly TDI payment is \$478 per week. Rhode Island is currently paying an average of 10.3 weeks per new claim. To date there have been 12,985 TDI initial claims filed.

**Temporary Caregiver Insurance** – Of the 876 TDI initial claims, 226 (25.8%) were TCI Claims. This week 456 TCI payments were issued totaling \$232,177. The average weekly TCI payment was \$509. Of the 12,985 TDI claims filed in 2016, 2,315 or 17.8% were TCI claims.






### UI Claims Comparison Year to Date
