*Weekly Update of Claims Activity*

*Week Ending: July 13, 2013*

***Unemployment Insurance***

**Initial Claims** – 1,740 initial claims were processed during the week ending 7/13/13, a decrease of 101 from the previous week, and a decrease of 217 from a year ago. The number of initial claims filed to date is down 6.3 percent from last year and down 6.8 percent from two years ago

**Continued Claims** – 12,259 continued claims were processed during the week of 7/13/13, an increase of 1,423 from the previous week and a decrease of 2,444 from a year ago. The number of continued claims filed to date is down 11.1 percent from last year and down 18.6 percent from two years ago.

**Workshare** – gives employers an alternative to layoffs by allowing employees to work reduced hours and collect a percentage of regular UI benefits to compensate for lost pay. This week, 15 initial claims and 356 continued claims were processed. An estimated 3 layoffs were prevented this week, as a result of Workshare.

**Emergency Unemployment Compensation 08** – EUC08, which became effective July 6, 2008, provides up to 53 weeks of federally funded benefits to eligible individuals who exhausted their UI claims. This week there were 282 new EUC08 claims processed and 6,227 continued claims processed (2,249 under tier I, 1,755 under tier II, 984 under tier III and 1,239 under tier IV).

**Exhaustions** – 312 individuals exhausted their regular payments this week, an increase of 51 from a year ago. There were 107 individuals that exhausted EUC08.

***Temporary Disability Insurance***

**Temporary Disability Insurance** – 1,196 initial claims and 6,812 continued claims were processed for Temporary Disability Insurance. The average weekly TDI payment is \$439 per week. Rhode Island is currently paying an average of 11.3 weeks per new claim.






### UI Claims Comparison Year to Date
