***Weekly Update of Claims Activity***

***Week Ending: August 6, 2016***

***Unemployment Insurance***

**Initial Claims** – 929 initial claims were processed during the week ending 8/6/16, an increase of 149 from the previous week, and an increase of 26 from a year ago. The number of initial claims filed to date is down 5.3 percent from last year and down 15.8 percent from two years ago.

**Continued Claims** – 9,404 continued claims were processed during the week of 8/6/16, a decrease of 231 from the previous week and a decrease of 269 from a year ago. The number of continued claims filed to date is down 9.7 percent from last year and down 21.5 percent from two years ago.

**Workshare** – gives employers an alternative to layoffs by allowing employees to work reduced hours and collect a percentage of regular UI benefits to compensate for lost pay. This week, 16 initial claims and 555 continued claims were processed. An estimated 7 layoffs were prevented this week, as a result of Workshare.

**Exhaustions** – 169 individuals exhausted their regular payments this week, an increase 10 from the previous week and a decrease of 10 from a year ago.

***Temporary Disability Insurance***

**Temporary Disability Insurance** – 931 initial claims and 7,359 continued claims were processed for Temporary Disability Insurance. The average weekly TDI payment is \$480 per week. Rhode Island is currently paying an average of 10.4 weeks per new claim. To date there have been 29,575 TDI initial claims filed.

**Temporary Caregiver Insurance** – Of the 931 TDI initial claims, 171 (18.4%) were TCI Claims. This week 336 TCI payments were issued totaling \$190,426. The average weekly TCI payment was \$567. Of the 29,575 TDI claims filed in 2016, 5,600 or 18.9% were TCI claims.






### UI Claims Comparison Year to Date
