**Public Notice of Proposed Rule-Making**

The Board of Review, under the authority granted by Chapter 42 of Title 28 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, as amended, granting the Board of Review the power to adopt, amend, modify and reject general and special rules and regulations under Chapter 35 of Title 42 of the General Laws of Rhode Island as amended, proposes the amendment of **Unemployment Insurance and Temporary Disability Insurance Rule 3 – Meaning of Terms** and creation of the new **Unemployment Insurance and Temporary Disability Insurance Rule 37 – Filing of Claims for Temporary Caregiver Insurance Benefits**. The proposed rule changes clarify the definition of Qualified Healthcare Provider or Medical Practitioner and outline the requirements to file for the new Temporary Caregiver Insurance benefits beginning in January 2014.

In the development of the proposed rule consideration was given to: (1) alternative approaches; (2) overlap or duplication with other statutory and regulatory provisions; and (3) significant economic impact on small businesses. Based on available information, no significant economic impact was identified nor are there any alternative approaches, duplications or overlaps with other state regulations.

All interested parties are invited to submit written or oral comments concerning the proposed regulations are welcomed and will be accepted within twenty (20) days of the date of publication of this notice. In accordance with Rhode Island General Law, Section 42-35-3, an oral hearing on these proposed amendments will be granted if requested by twenty-five (25) persons or a governmental subdivision or agency, or by an association having not less than twenty-five (25) members. A request for an oral hearing must be made within thirty (30) days of the date of publication of this notice.
