Information you enter as a registered EmployRI user is saved online in your personal profile. The system will save any searches you conduct, including industry and occupational profiles, so you don't need to retrace your steps each time you log on. It can also update your list of employable skills as you receive relevant training.

Your personal profile can hold up to 10 versions of your résumé, as well as 10 cover letters and numerous appointments and notes. EmployRI can even keep track of your appointments and interviews.

Jobs in EmployRI are updated **every business day**; other data is updated as it is released, so you can be certain that you're viewing the most up-to-date information. In fact, EmployRI can also notify you when new job postings become available!

EmployRI is closely integrated with other Labor and Training programs, so services like Unemployment Insurance, Temporary Disability and Workforce Development are only a click away.
