

The Community College of Rhode Island is Rhode Island's only public two-year, degree-granting institution and the largest community college in New England, offering nearly 80 degree and certificate programs. CCRI grants the Associate in Arts (A.A.), Science (A.S.), Applied Science (A.A.S.), Applied Science in Technical Studies (A.A.S.-T.S.) and Fine Arts (A.F.A.).

CCRI became a Cisco Academy in 1998, soon was designated as a Regional Academy for the CCNA-Security curriculum, and during the same time period, became the local Academy for the Cisco Certified Network Professional (CCNP) curriculum. CCRI is currently one of only two schools to offer CCNP in New England. CCRI also applied and became an Instructor Training Center (ITC), and as such is certified to train instructors worldwide.
