The pilot cohort of the Web Development Immersive course is designed to prepare up to 25 residents of RI with in-demand web development skills and increase the overall pipeline of tech talent for local businesses.

Offered free of cost to selected applicants that complete General Assembly's competitive application process; this program is designed to be a flexible path for residents of Rhode Island who are committed to training for and connecting to full-time employment as entry-level Web Developers.
