Course Outline/Topics to be Covered

The program consists of 5 phases; 1) General Medical Studies (about 5 weeks): students receive training in Infection Control, Basic Human Anatomy & Physiology, Medical Terminology, CPR, 1st Aid, Legal issues, Communication, & Documentation. 2) EKG Core Curriculum portion (about 5-7 weeks), students learn about the EKG Technician profession, how to obtain and interpret 12-Lead EKGs, how to perform stress testing, and the use of holter monitoring. All work is done on live human 'patients'. 3) Phlebotomy Core Curriculum (about 5-7 weeks), students learn about the phlebotomy profession, how to obtain blood & non-blood samples, and laboratory procedures as well as performing blood draws on manikins and human patients'. 4) Job Readiness includes includes 12 hours resume writing, interview techniques, job etiquette, and computer job searches. 6) The Simulated Clinical / Externship session prepares students for work in a hospital/clinic environment. Upon completion of the didactic portion, students sit for the National Healthcareer Association Certification Examination.

Additional Information

Different options depending on students ability : 12 weeks: Class is 2 nights a week at 3 hour sessions for 5 weeks, then either 2 nights week for 14 weeks or 4 nights a week for 7 weeks hour sessions followed by two 40 hr weeks of externship. If student requires a longer externship based on Hospital evaluation..additional time may be needed. Also, if student requires remedial/contextual learning due to low test scores, add'l time may be required for successful course completion.
