### Course Outline/Topics to be Covered

The program consists of 4 phases: 1) General Medical Studies (about 5 weeks): students receive training in Infection Control, Basic Human Anatomy & Physiology, Medical Terminology, CPR, 1st Aid, Legal issues, Communication, & Documentation. 2) Core Curriculum portion (about 5-7 weeks), students learn about the EKG Technician profession, how to obtain and interpret 12-Lead EKGs, how to perform stress testing, and the use of holter monitoring. All work is done on live human 'patients'. 3) Job Readiness includes 12 hours resume writing, interview techniques, job etiquette, and computer job searches. 4) The Simulated Clinical / Externship session prepares students for work in a hospital/clinic environment. Students receive patients, review tests ordered, obtain EKGs and perform required testing. Upon completion of the didactic portion, students sit for the National Healthcareer Association Certification Examination.
