Course Outline/Topics to be Covered

The ACT Program's 15-week course of study consists of classroom and practical hands-on experiences derived from the National Center for Construction Education and Research, New Environment, Inc. Hazardous Waste Worker Emergency Response Technician Course 29CFR 1910.120 (e)& (q) Version B, The Red Cross, the Lead Safe Remodeler/Renovator Course of the Childhood Lead Action Project, and field training from Tobey , Inc. The curriculum includes an introduction to the trade, math, communications and employability skills, safety, hand and power tools, basic blueprint reading, materials and fasteners, stair layout, windows, doors, roof framing, wall and ceiling framing, and floor systems. Students will be afforded employment options in hazardous waste practices, basic carpentry, and heavy equipment training in Bobcat, Loader and backhoe. Students may also work on community service projects and will have access to assistance in literacy (math and reading), can pursue an external high school diploma, and can access case management and social services at Amos House as needed.
