Ace is a 12-week program that provides training in food safety and sanitation, basic nutritional science, recipes and menu development, tools and equipment, knife skills, kitchen management, food preparation, storage and handling, measurement and conversion, customer service, and the history and diversity of food preparation. Students receive real-world experience in a simulated bistro and through internships at local restaurants. They are prepared for ServSafe certification as well as CPR and First Aid certification. Students also have access to adult basic education classes, tutorial assistance, the opportunity to pursue an external high school diploma and social services at Amos House as needed. Total hours: 420.
