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Course Outline/Topics to be Covered

Occupational therapy uses everyday activities as the means to help people achieve independence in self care, functional mobility, home management, success with social participation, environmental modification, adaptive equipment design, splint fabrication and education. The program integrates classroom preparation and clinical practice. General education courses such as English Composition, Oral Communication, Anatomy, Physiology, Math, and Psychology enhance the Occupational Therapy Assistant program core courses. Courses include laboratory sessions to learn skills required to be an occupational therapy assistant. Students participate in fieldwork experiences in a variety of occupational therapy settings such as hospitals, rehab centers, hand clinics, schools, psychiatric centers, and skilled nursing facilities. Graduates must take a national certification exam to be eligible for licensure in RI.
