Course Outline/Topics to be Covered

This is an intense (105 hours) course which includes all areas of responsibility of a well trained pharmacy technician. Topic areas covered are basic pharmacology, prescription dispensing, prescription medications, OTC drugs, pharmacy calculations-conversions, medical terminology, disease states, aseptic techniques, patient interactions, etc. When this classroom time is complete, students will sit for national certification exam (see below) and upon successful completion will obtain state license and enter Externship portion (60 hours), sites to be arranged by vendor (MRxI/Kushan Education).
