Course Outline/Topics to be Covered

The physical therapist assistant works under the direction of a licensed physical therapist. They provide services to improve strength, flexibility, relieve pain, promote fitness and quality of life of people suffering from injuries or disease. The PTA Program is a two-year day program that integrates classroom preparation and clinical practice. General education courses such as English Composition, Oral Communication, Anatomy, Physiology, Math and Psychology enhance the Physical Therapist Assistant program core courses. Core courses include laboratory sessions to learn and practice the hands on skills required to be a physical therapist assistant. The students have three clinical education experiences in various physical therapy settings to utilize skills in the clinic that were learned in the classroom with patients in the clinic. Following graduation students are eligible to take, and must pass, a national examination to become a licensed Physical Therapist Assistant in RI.
