Course Outline/Topics to be Covered

The Confident Captain/Ocean Pros OUPV curriculum calls for 57 hours of classroom training, as required by the US Coast Guard, in lieu of the Coast Guard exam. The curriculum includes formal classroom training in deck safety, general deck duties. Requirements of the program:
1. 360 Days of on the water experience- minimum 4 hours per day; 1 day logged per calendar day
2. 90 of the 360 days must be within the past three years
3. 90 of the 360 days must be outside of the boundary lines
4. 50% of the experience must be obtained after the age of 16
5. The candidate must be 18 years of age to enroll in an OUPV/Six-Pak Course
