The Homemaker class equips trainees with the basic in the growing field of home health care. Classes combine work readiness with content areas including: An Introduction to the Home Care Industry, Communication Skills, Basic Human Needs, Food and Nutrition, Body Systems and Body Mechanics, Infection Control/Fire Safety and Injury Prevention, and Housework. Full support of job developer, (soft skills training, mock interviews, resume building and job placement assistance); Transition Specialist (assistance with access to further trainings and higher education), health coordinator and case management provided. Graduates will receive Red Cross first aid/CPR certificates, First Impressions customer service certification, and an Alzheimer's Care certification. Trainees are well prepared to become home health care workers or pursue further training in pre-CNA or CNA.
