The Dental Assisting program is designed to prepare the student with a strong foundation on which to build a successful career as a competent entry-level dental assistant. A well-rounded curriculum offers the student knowledge and skills in the technical areas of preventive dentistry, four-handed dentistry, chair side assisting with emphasis in diagnostics, operative, fixed prosthodontics, pediatric dentistry, orthodontic procedures, endodontic procedures, surgical procedures, and expanded functions, and dental radiology. Because of the wide range of opportunities for the graduate, the program also focuses on the business aspects of a dental practice including practice management. Upon graduation from the program, students are encouraged to sit for the Certified Dental Assisting (CDA) examination. The CDA examination is made up of three separate examinations: General Chairside (GC), Infectious Control (IC), and Radiation Health and Safety (RHS).
