Our massage therapy program provides a broad-based entry-level education. Upon completion of this program, the student will qualify to sit for the National Certification Exam for Therapeutic Massage and Bodywork. By passing this exam, the student will then be eligible for licensure as a Massage Therapist in Connecticut as well as being a Nationally Certified Massage Therapist. This status allows potential employers to know the skill level of the graduate and makes them eligible to be employed in a facility that incorporates massage therapy. A strong knowledge of anatomy & physiology, pathology, kinesiology, therapeutic massage, spa services, along with legal and ethical issues of massage is necessary to be proficient as a massage therapist. We provide training in these essential areas of study for a well-rounded program.
