The Cardiovascular Sonography Program is designed to prepare students to perform echocardiographic exams under the direction of a physician or cardiologist. Students gain both didactic knowledge & practical experience in cardiovascular science, EKG, holter monitoring, telemetry and echocardiography. Students study the anatomy, physiology & pathophysiology of the organ systems, recognize the EKG patterns of infraction, arrhythmia recognition, appreciate emergency protocols, and perform echocardiography. The core curriculum includes a lecture component, an imaging laboratory component, and a clinical component. The externship portion of the program includes supervised experiences in a clinical environment.
