The student will have the opportunity to study the anatomy, physiology & pathophysiology of scanned organs, recognize the sonographic patterns of the organs, learn the protocols for a logical and thorough survey of the organs and provide accurate and technical impressions to the interpreting physician. The externship portion of the program includes supervised experiences in a clinical setting.
