Industry Certifications

Graduates of the Medical Assisting Program may choose to take certification exams. Certification may enhance employment opportunities.

- CMA exam (Certified Medical Assistant) offered by the AAMA (American Association of Medical Assistants).

Cost: \$125 for members, \$250 for non-members.

- RMA exam (Registered Medical Assistant) offered by the AMT (American Medical Technologist Assoc).

Cost: \$95. For additional information, visit the AMT website,

- NCMA exam (National Certified Medical Assistant) offered by the NCCT (National Center for Competency Testing)

Cost: \$90 for students and graduates (within 6 months) of an accredited medical assisting program. After 6 months, exam increases to \$135. See website for additional details, www.ncctinc.com

Note:

SBI Cranston will pay for one certification exam. Certification exam to be determined by SBI Cranston. A student/graduate may choose to obtain several certifications at their own cost. For further details, please contact the school.

Sanford-Brown Institute, Cranston RI Campus & RIPTA Partnership

Students wishing to utilize RIPTA to attend school may do so at no cost. RIPTA will provide services within the town of Cranston and the State of Rhode Island with routes servicing the school campus.

Sanford-Brown Institute and RIPTA transportation service agreement is as follows:

- Sanford-Brown Institute shall pay for students' transportation to and from school.
- Students who sign up for the RIPTA program will inform the school of the address they will depart from daily to attend school. The school will document this address. Sanford-Brown will only pay fares to and from school, with one address documented as the address where the student will depart daily.
- Students will be given a pre-programmed Farebox/Sanford-Brown Photo ID to be used to access Bus Services. The student must present this ID upon boarding the bus. This ID will be readable by the RIPTA automated Farebox.
- Sanford-Brown will receive a detailed monthly report on each student's bus usage, and Sanford-Brown will pay for the bus trips to and from school.

Note: Sanford-Brown will only pay for trips to and from school. If a student uses the pass for other transportation services, the Farebox/Sanford-Brown Photo ID will be immediately revoked, and the free bus service will be permanently terminated.
