The Pharmacy Technician Certification Board (PTCB) is governed by five organizations: the American Pharmacists Association; the American Society of Health-System Pharmacists; the Illinois Council of Health-System Pharmacists; the Michigan Pharmacists Association; and the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy. PTCB has advocated for a single national standard for pharmacy technician certification that is recognized and supported by the profession.
