2. High school transcript - Send an official copy of a high school transcript or GED, including date of graduation must be provided.

If the applicant holds a baccalaureate degree from an accredited college/university, the high school transcript may be waived, college transcript must indicate completion and degree awarded.

3. Placement testing - Complete a standardized test (ACCUPLACER) issued by CCRI's Department of Advising and Counseling.
