### Course Outline/Topics to be Covered

Students will start each morning in the classroom from 8:00 until 10:20am, then will work in the field every day from 10:30am - 4:30 pm, with a half hour lunch break. The normal length of time to complete the program is 15 weeks of full time enrollment, which is approximately 500 clock hours. All courses are rated at the 100 level, which are beginning level courses for apprentice lineworkers. The classroom classes taught are ES-100 Electrical Systems, TR-100 Transformers, BE-100 Basic Electricity, GR-100 Personal Protective Grounding, RI-100 Rigging, CP-100 Career Planning and Strategies. Other courses Metering 4 classroom hrs./8 field hrs. Underground 4 classroom hrs./6 field hrs. In the field, students must complete competencies in order to receive a certificate of completion. Certifications: OSHA 10 Hour Certification, (10 clock hrs.) First Aid/CPR (3 clock hrs), NSC Flagger's Certification (3 clock hrs), Pole -Top Bucket Truck Rescue (3 clock hrs), Class A CDL License
