SUBJECT: American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (Recovery Act) stimulus allocations for Adult, Youth, and Dislocated Worker Programs for Program Year 2008

DATE: April 14, 2009

- 1. PURPOSE.** To provide Locals with the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Adult, Youth, and Dislocated Worker (DW) Recovery Act stimulus allocations for PY 2008.
- 2. REFERENCES.** WIN 08-11 (Change 1) that transmitted to you the WIA percentage allocations for the Adult and Youth programs, and WIN 08-13 that addressed percentage allocations for the Dislocated Worker program; TEGL 13-08.
- 3. BACKGROUND.** The funds for the allotments issued are part of the Recovery Act P.L. 111-5 signed into law February 17, 2009. States are expected to spend Recovery Act funding quickly and effectively. Recovery Act funding for Adults, Dislocated Workers, and Youth are considered to be PY 2008 funds and, must be expended by the end of PY 2010 (June 30, 2011). Therefore, the period of funding is February 17, 2009 – June 30, 2011. It is the intent of Congress, as well as that of the Administration, that the majority of these funds will be utilized within the first year of availability.

WIA ALLOCATIONS FOR ADULT PROGRAMS

The State allocation for Adults is **\$2,106,542**. The State Set-Aside for Adults is 15%, which equals **\$315,981**. The remaining 85%, equaling **\$1,790,561**, is distributed to the Local Areas according to the percentage allocation formula.

WIA ALLOCATIONS FOR YOUTH PROGRAMS

The State allocation for Youth is **\$5,611,097**. The State Set-Aside for Youth is 15%, which equals **\$841,664**. The remaining 85%, equaling **\$4,769,433**, is distributed to the Local Areas according to the percentage allocation formula.

WIA ALLOCATIONS FOR DISLOCATED WORKER PROGRAMS

The State allocation for DW is **\$7,945,909**. The State Set-Aside for DW is 15%, which equals **\$1,191,886**. In addition, 25% of the DW allocation is reserved for Rapid Response which equals **\$1,986,477**. The remaining 60%, equaling **\$4,767,546**, is distributed to the Local Areas according to the percentage allocation formula.

4. FINANCIAL REPORTING for RECOVERY ACT FUNDS. States are required to track financial information separately for each of the funding streams. States will submit the standard ETA-9130 reports with locals reporting Adult, Youth, and DW activities as they pertain to the Recovery Act funds. The first quarterly report will be for period ending March 31, 2009, due 45 days after the end of the quarter. Please specify Recovery Act within line 5 of the ETA-9130 report (Recipient Account Number or Identifying Number) along with the appropriate funding stream.

In summary, WIA allocations for the Recovery Act for Adult, Youth, and DW programs are:
