## **WORKFORCE INVESTMENT NOTICE: 10-22**

**SUBJECT:** Changes in Dislocated Worker Allocations for PY10/ FY11

**DATE:** April 19, 2011

**1. Purpose.** To provide guidance on the State Workforce Investment Office's distribution of additional Dislocated Worker monies to the Workforce Partnership of Greater Rhode Island (WPGRI).

**3. Background.** WPGRI has fully obligated their DW program allocation and is in jeopardy of not being able to serve the existing training needs of its dislocated citizens. In response, effective immediately, the State Workforce Investment Office will make available to WPGRI an additional \$1,300,000 of PY 2010 Formula Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Dislocated Worker monies so that WPGRI can continue to serve the training needs of their dislocated workers. None of these funds will be available for administrative expenses.

**4. Reporting.** The additional funding will now be added to the WPGRI DW allocations in the WIA Formula funding stream and will be reduced from the amount previously reserved for Rapid Response activities at the State level accordingly. The June 30, 2011 quarterly reports will reflect the new availabilities.
