**SUBJECT:** Changes in Adult and Dislocated Worker Funds for PY2010

**DATE:** September 19, 2011

**1. Purpose.** To provide guidance on ETA plans to adjust FY11 portion of PY10 allocations for Adult and Dislocated Worker regarding the 0.2 percent rescission, recapture and \$1,300,000 of Dislocated Worker funds to Workforce Partnership of Greater Rhode Island (WPGRI).

**3. Background.** During FY2011, DOL is required to apply a rescission of 0.2 percent to all FY 2011 discretionary programs. This adjustment will be applied to WIA Adult and Dislocated Worker program formula allotted funds for FY2011. The recapture was absorbed 100% at the State level. Additionally the \$1,300,000 of

Dislocated Worker funds transferred to WPGRI will also be addressed in the table below.

**4. Reporting.** Local Areas should reflect decreased total Federal funds authorized on the appropriate line items of the proper Quarterly Report beginning with the quarter ending June 30, 2011 consistent with the effective date of the NOOs adjustment of the funds. Local Areas should also report obligations and outlays consistent with the revised authorized funding levels for such quarters.

For any local that has already submitted a final FY2011 Adult and or Dislocated Worker Quarterly Report, revised reports for that period will be necessary reflecting FY2011 splits with adjustments for Adult and Dislocated Workers.
