## **WORKFORCE INVESTMENT NOTICE: 12-01**

**SUBJECT:** Adult and Dislocated Worker Allocations for PY 2012

**DATE:** August 27, 2012

**1. Purpose** To transmit the PY 2012/ FY 2013 split for Adult and Dislocated Worker Programs.

**2. References** WIN 11-23; WIN 11-24; WIN 11-25; WIN 11-26

**3. Background** The funds for the allotments announced in this notice are part of the FY 2013 funds appropriated in the Department of Labor Appropriations Act, 2012, Division F, Title I of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2012, P.L. 112-74, signed into law December 23, 2011. As well as the Continuing Appropriations Act, 2012, P.L. 112-33, Sections 101, 115, and 133, enacted September 30, 2011, and Continuing Appropriation Act, 2012 P.L. 112-36, Sections 101, 115, and 133, enacted October 5, 2011. National allotments for Adult and Dislocated Worker Programs are issued to states by Notice of Obligations (NOO). For PY 2012, Congress appropriated funds for these programs in two portions. The effect of this was to cause the PY 2012 Allocations for Adult and Dislocated Worker Programs to be split into two funding streams, specifically PY 2012 which is available for expenditure on July 1, 2012, and FY 2013 which is available for expenditure October 1, 2012. Each portion of funds is to be **tracked and reported separately**.

**4. Allocation of Funds** Below are charts that split your allocations for Adult and Dislocated Worker Programs into PY 2012 and FY 2013 as provided to you in WINs 11-25 and 11-26. Since FY 2013 funds do not become available for expenditure until October 1, 2012, reports for FY 2013 funds are required with the reporting period ending December 31, 2012.
