<b>Providers:</b>		<b>Summer</b>
Cranston Area Career and Technical Center & Providence Career and Technical Academy	Providence or Cranston Middle school youth at risk of dropping out of school.	2010 SUMMER ONLY. Participants will spend 6 weeks exploring 6 different vocational areas while exposing youth to "hands on" contextualized learning. Youth will be paid a stipend equivalent to \$7.40 per hour, which will be connected to their individual performance. <i>Please contact the Providence and Cranston YouthWORKS411 Centers to apply for this program.</i>
<b>Providers:</b>		<b>Comprehensive Programs that require a two year commitment:</b>
Boys and Girls Clubs of Providence	Ages 14 to 18 Providence In-School	This program includes job training and paid summer and school year employment. During the school year the program will also focus on career preparation, job development, education and the Skills Tech computer skills curriculum.
Comprehensive Community Action Program – Younger	Ages 16 to 18 Providence or Cranston Out of School	Offered at the Skills Center at the Providence Place Mall, this program assists out of school young people in obtaining a GED if needed, academic skills development and preparation for work or continued education.
Comprehensive Community Action Program – Older	Ages 19 to 21 Providence or Cranston Out of School	Offered at the Skills Center at the Providence Place Mall, this program assists out of school young people in obtaining a GED if needed as well as Occupational Skills Training for employment.
Urban League of RI	Ages 14-18 Providence In-School	Participants will receive work readiness, work experiences, leadership development, academic skills during the summer and throughout the academic year.
Providence Youth Center (Goodwill Industries)	Ages 14-24 In school or Out of School Providence or Cranston	Participants will be enrolled in JDF and receive work readiness assistance from the Youth Center. Some participants will be enrolled in the year-round WIA program through the Youth Center. Some services will be provided at the youth center and youth will be referred out for some services.
Cranston Youth Center (CCAP)	Ages 14-24 In school or Out of School Providence or Cranston	Participants will be enrolled in JDF and receive work readiness assistance from the Youth Center. Some participants will be enrolled in the year-round WIA program through the Youth Center. Some services will be provided at the youth center and youth will be referred out for some services.

Institute for Labor Studies & Research	Ages 14-21 In school or Out of School Providence or Cranston	Extended from the 2009 program year, this program will provide an Introduction to Apprenticeships. Participants interested in applying for union apprenticeship programs will be able to enroll in a class that will provide the math skills needed for apprenticeship programs.
