# Programs

**College Prep Services**-Work with staff to identify the appropriate college for you, go on local college tours, get one-one-one help with college applications and the FAFSA paperwork. Learn tools for studying for your SATs.

**My Skills Tutor** is an online academic enrichment tool that quickly increases academic performance. It is your own personal tutor that you can have access to 24 hours a day from wherever you are. This program is easy to use and can assist you with any subject in which you are experiencing difficulty.

**YOUTH PLUS** is a **credit recovery** program in partnership with the Woonsocket School Department. In this program students are able to catch up on lost English, Math, Science and History credits during after school hours with teacher instruction.

**The Youth Programming Council** is made up of Youth Center members that work together to



create and implement interesting and educational programming for all youth center members. The YPC

meets every Thursday at 4pm in the FRCA youth center and is open to all youth center participants.
